# CITY OF ANNAPOLIS NOTICE OF A PROPOSED REAL PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City Council of City of Annapolis proposes to increase real property taxes.

- 1. For the tax year beginning July 1, 2020, the estimated real property assessable base will increase by 3.0%, from \$6,931,502,914 to \$7,139,728,852.
- 2. If City of Annapolis maintains the current tax rate of \$0.7380 per \$100 of assessment, real property tax revenues will increase by 3.0 % resulting in \$1,536,707 of new real property tax revenues.
- 3. In order to fully offset the effect of increasing assessments, the real property tax rate should be reduced to \$0.7165, the constant yield tax rate.
- 4. The City of Annapolis is considering not reducing its real property tax rate enough to fully offset increasing assessments. The City of Annapolis proposes to adopt a real property tax rate of \$0.7380 per \$100 of assessment. This tax rate is 3.0% higher than the constant yield tax rate and will generate \$1,536,707 in additional property tax revenues.

A public hearing on the proposed real property tax rate increase will be held at

7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 26, 2020, during the virtual City Council Meeting hosted by City of Annapolis located at 160 Duke of Gloucester Street, 2nd Floor, Annapolis, Maryland 21401.
