

## STAFF REPORT ON PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Subject: O-29-19: Purchasing and Procurement

This ordinance codifies regulations governing all City purchases. The City's procurement laws were repealed in 1990, and the City's procurements are currently governed by a 4-page policy that does not have the force of law.

Procurement policies have a profound impact on the cost of implementing government programs and services. These proposed regulations are designed to codify efficient and transparent policies and procedures that are essential to ensuring fair and impartial procurements. The Central Purchasing Office is prepared to implement these regulations upon adoption.
