

Project Phase Design and Construction

Project Description:

The existing pool is approximately 51 years old, and the only major renovation of the pool occurred 26 years ago. The pool is susceptible to water loss, equipment malfunction, and closures. The pool and bathhouse do not comply with Americans with Disabilities Act guidelines. The design/build team has been selected to construct a new pool. The existing pool will be open for one last summer season in 2019, and the new pool will be open by June 2020. The new pool facilities will be in the same location as the existing pool and will include a new bathhouse; a competitive 25-yard, six-lane lap pool; a family leisure pool; a splash pad; a snack bar; and ample shaded patio areas. Additional funds are requested at this time to improve the parking lot and purchase furniture.
