32 33	WHEREAS,	Section 6.04.210 of the City Code states that "whenever a person leases,	
34		uses or occupies a City facility, the person shall be charged and pay a minimum of full fees for the use of the facility." Examples of City facilities	
35		include public spaces, grounds, parks, athletic facilities, fields, docks, piers,	
36		wet slips, moorings, developable waters, buildings, motor vehicles,	
37		equipment, structures, rooms or other parts of public buildings. Examples	
38		of City services include traffic control, crowd control, public safety support	
39		(police or fire), trash removal, sanitary services, recycling, bulk pick-up, the	
40		provision of water, sewer, electricity, communications or other utilities,	
41		transportation, and labor. Full fees "means the value of the right to lease,	
42		use or occupy the City facility as determined by the Finance Director in a	
43		fiscal impact note, plus all costs incurred by the City of Annapolis	
44		including, but not limited to, utility costs and costs associated with	

1		municipal services (public safety, public works, custodial, renovations, repairs, maintenance, transportation and parking)"; and
