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- A. PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. It is unlawful and a misdemeanor for the driver of any motor vehicle to park a vehicle in a parking space, whether metered or unmetered, designated or reserved for physically disabled persons, unless the vehicle displays either a valid special registration plate for disabled persons or a valid disabled person's parking permit issued by the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration.
- B. PLUG-IN ELECTRIC DRIVE VEHICLES. UNLESS THE VEHICLE IS A PLUG-IN ELECTRIC DRIVE VEHICLE AS DEFINED BY THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE MARYLAND ANNOTATED CODE, AS MAY BE AMENDED, A PERSON MAY NOT STOP, STAND, OR PARK A VEHICLE IN A DESIGNATED PLUG-IN ELECTRIC
