## **ANALYSIS**

The Planning Commission received several briefings on the strategy issued by the Maritime Zoning Task Force. The strategy provides the informational and strategic background to several pieces of legislation, some already introduced and some to-be-introduced.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Planning Commission held several public hearings related to the progress and final version of this strategy. At public hearings on this legislation on July 15, 2021 and August 5, 2021, the facts, conclusions and recommendations of the strategy were discussed. Deliberations were concluded on August 23, 2021.

By a vote of 5-0 on August 23, 2021, the Planning Commission substantially endorsed the information, findings, recommendations, and proposed implementations in this strategy. The Commission understands this strategy will be addended to and become a part of the Comprehensive Plan. The Commission recommends to the City Council it **APPROVE** this strategy.
