FOR the purpose of repealing fines in the Fiscal Year 2021 Fines Schedule for violations concerning loitering in Drug-Loitering Free Zones.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 49-20 repeals Section 11.12.067 of the Code of the City of Annapolis concerning Drug-Loitering Free Zones; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 65-20 repeals the fines set forth in the FY2021 Fees Schedule for violations of

Section 11.12.067.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that the Fiscal Year 2021 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:

Code Reference	Description	Fine for Initial Offense	Fine for Repeat or Continuous Violations
11.12.067.E	Loitering in drug-loitering free zones	Not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding six months or both	Not to exceed \$1,000.00 or imprisonment not exceeding six months or both

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this resolution shall become effective upon the effective date of Ordinance 49-20.
