32 33 34 35	WHEREAS, The Military Bowl game, organized by the non-profit Military Bowl Foundation, benefits the USO and Patriot Point, the Military Bowl Foundation's 294-acre retreat for recovering service members, their families and caregivers; and

10 11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, The five-year average Military Bowl game attendance is 27,525 people, leading to an overnight stay of an estimated 22,681 visitors, according to a 2019 survey by Visit Annapolis and Anne Arundel County Conference & Visitors Bureau; and		

1	WHEREAS,	The 2019 survey also found that the Military Bowl led to \$18,912,214 in direct
2		business sales, supported 8,820 local jobs, and contributed to \$1,058,694 in local
3		taxes.

5	WHEREAS,	The Military Bowl Football Game at 2 p.m. ET on Wednesday, December 27, 2023,
6		is broadcast by ESPN with a viewing audience of more than 2.2 million people,
7		placing a national spotlight on the City of Annapolis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Annapolis recognizes Military Bowl events contribute to the local economy, promote tourism and foster a welcoming spirit among residents and visitors alike; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that:

1. The Military Bowl Parade and Football Game that will be held on Wednesday, December 27, 2023, is hereby designated a Major Special Event in recognition of its significance to our heritage and public service to our City; and

2. The City of Annapolis hereby waives reimbursement for the costs associated with the Military Bowl Parade and Football Game to be held Wednesday, December 27, 2023, up to a maximum of \$15,000, including but not limited to costs for providing security, cleanup and other related services; and

3. This waiver of fees is intended to express the city's appreciation for the annual Military Bowl's positive impact on the community and its commitment to fostering a welcoming and vibrant atmosphere for residents and visitors.

AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL that this resolution shall take effect upon passage.
