City Council Citation


On behalf of the residents of the City of Annapolis, we present you with this City Council Citation for your lifesaving actions and dedication to public service. On September 14, 2025, at Peninsula Athletic League (PAL) Park, you responded to what was initially reported as a fainting incident that was quickly upgraded to a cardiac arrest. Upon the Annapolis Fire Department's arrival, you were already performing CPR alongside Governor Moore's Security Detail. Their team deployed an AED and delivered two shocks before Medic Unit 48 assumed patient care. Working seamlessly together, responders administered additional lifesaving interventions, including medications and two more shocks. As crews prepared for advanced airway management, the patient exhibited a gag reflex and a pulse check confirmed the return of spontaneous circulation. During transport to Anne Arundel Medical Center, the patient regained consciousness and was alert upon arrival, later being released home on September 19, 2025. Your swift action and professionalism represent the very best of the City of Annapolis and the Annapolis Fire Department.


