# WHAT DO WE DO?

The Annapolis Area Imagination Library is a book gifting program that mails free, high-quality books to children from birth to age five - regardless of family income.



## We are an affiliate of the national Dolly Parton Imagination Library.

The national organization:

- Selects the books
- Mails books
- Administers program - covers overhead costs



Our local organization:

- Registers children
- Raises money to cover cost of books and mailing - \$2.20/child/month or \$26/child/year

# OUR REACH:

- In May of 2023, we mailed 667 books to children in Annapolis
- In May of 2024, we will be mailing 1108 books to children in Annapolis
- COST:  $1108 \times \$26 = \$28,808$





## OUR FOCUS - Low income and immigrant families

We register children in person at:

- Food pantries
- Diaper banks
- Events at targeted schools
- Community celebrations and resource fairs

Over 80% of the children we serve are from either low-income or immigrant families.

# EVIDENCE THAT THE DOLLY PARTON PROGRAM WORKS

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- Children with 20+ books in the home get on average 3 more years of education than children without books in the home
- Having books in the home is more powerful than having a parent with a university education
- Families who receive books from the DPIL read more together as they participate in the program
