13 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

15 **City Attorney – D. Michael Lyles**

17 **FOR** the purpose of expressly confirming the appointment of D. Michael Lyles as City Attorney;  
18 consenting to compensate the City Attorney; and setting an effective date.

20 **WHEREAS,** the Annapolis City Code, Section 2.12.040.B provides that “[t]he City Attorney  
21 shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council”; and

22  
23 **WHEREAS,** the Annapolis City Code, Section 3.08.030.F.1(ii) provides that the appointment  
24 and initial salary for the City Attorney is subject to confirmation by the City  
25 Council; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the City Attorney position became vacant on March 8, 2019; and

28  
29 **WHEREAS,** the education, training and experience of D. Michael Lyles exceeds the minimum  
30 qualifications required for the City Attorney position; and

32 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to the foregoing Annapolis Charter and City Code provisions, the City  
33 Council is required to expressly consent to the confirmation and compensation of  
34 the City Attorney.

36 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

38 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the City Council expressly  
39 confirms the appointment of D. Michael Lyles to the position of City Attorney and consents to  
40 compensate D. Michael Lyles as City Attorney in the amount of \$157,480 per annum commencing  
41 December 10, 2019.
