The Reality of Annapolis' Government Structure

- ▶ The Mayor is the Executive, not just ceremonial
- ▶ Mayor is highly active politically and regionally
- ▶ Mayor's Office leads policy, communications, and involved in cross department initiatives & issues
- ▶ Current structure is stretched beyond sustainable capacity



Why Now?

- ▶ Increasing intergovernmental, business and resident demands
- ▶ Need for faster response, execution and clearer accountability
- ▶ Growth and redevelopment pressures such as Choice Neighborhood Initiatives (CNI)
- ▶ Complex projects like City Dock



Chief of Staff: Current Responsibilities

- ▶ **Strategic Advisor** and trusted confidant to Mayor
- ▶ **Strategic Coordination**, sets priorities and long-term goals
- ▶ **Executive Support**, manages Mayor's schedule, workflow and agendas
- ▶ **Stakeholder & Intergovernmental Relations**
- ▶ **Leads Crisis & Issue Management**
- ▶ **Manages Mayor's Office Budget & Supervises Staff**
 - ▶ Outreach Team
 - ▶ Communications/PIO
 - ▶ Constituent Services/Ombudsman
 - ▶ Community Engagement



What a Deputy Chief of Staff Does

- ▶ **Senior advisor**
 - ▶ Oversees key policy portfolios like housing
- ▶ **Operational support** for COS
- ▶ **Supports issue response and special initiatives**
 - ▶ Troubleshoots stalled initiatives
 - ▶ Manages cross-departmental issues
 - ▶ Ensures follow-through on mayoral decisions
- ▶ **Acts on behalf of the Chief of Staff when needed**
- ▶ **City Council & Stakeholder Coordination** (see next slide)



Council & Stakeholder Coordination

- ▶ **Point person for City Council**
 - ▶ Single source for all support from the Mayor's office
 - ▶ Streamlined communication that reduces delays, eliminates duplication, and keeps leadership aligned
 - ▶ Drives policy and follow-through
 - ▶ Supports City Council agendas and work sessions
- ▶ **Manages relationships with community and business leaders**
 - ▶ City of Annapolis Internship Program
- ▶ **Coordinates intergovernmental and diplomatic initiatives**
 - ▶ Sister Cities (14) - Diplomatic outreach, visits, and events



The Bottom Line

- ▶ Deputy Chief of Staff adds capacity including speed, coordination, and reliability from the Mayor's Office
- ▶ Improves outcomes for departments and residents
- ▶ Frees Mayor and COS to focus on top priorities
- ▶ A practical step to achieve "Annapolis Works"
