Amendment Summary:

Amendment 7 allows the Art in Public Places Commission to authorize art projects from the Arts Fund. Any authorization more than \$40,000 requires approval from the Planning and Zoning Director.

MOTION:

- 1) On page 7, in line 9, strike “Funding Recommendations.” and insert “Funding Authorization.”; strike “make recommendations regarding the use of” and insert “Evaluate and fund projects through”.
- 2) On page 7, in line 5, after “spaces.” insert “Projects over \$40,000 shall require approval from the Planning and Zoning Director or their designee.”

Section 2.48.720 Duties and Responsibilities

A. The Commission shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

3. ~~Funding Recommendations~~Authorization. ~~Make recommendations regarding the use of~~Evaluate and fund projects through the art fund, including work of art funding, artist selection processes, and related expenditures, in accordance with applicable law and adopted procedures of the Commission, including those procedures adopted pursuant to § 2.48.740. Projects over \$40,000 shall require approval from the Planning and Zoning Director or their designee.

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
