Compostable Food Waste

22

23 **FOR** the purpose of amending the Annapolis City Code definition of “Solid Waste” to
24 exclude compostable food waste; to exempt collectors of compostable food waste from
25 having to obtain a solid waste permit and pay the associated fee; and matters generally
26 relating to the collection of compostable food waste.

28 **BY** repealing and re-enacting with amendments the following portions of the Code of
29 the City of Annapolis, 2015 Edition

33 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS**
34 **CITY COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as
35 follows:

37 **Chapter 10.16 - SOLID WASTE**

39 **Article I - General Provisions**

40

41 **Section 10.16.005 - Definitions.**

42

43 For the purposes of this chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings
44 respectively ascribed to them by this section:

45

- 1 A. "Approved refuse container" means a container meeting the requirements of this
2 chapter and used for holding solid waste.
- 3 B. "Bulk items" means household items such as sofas, chairs, tables, toilets, kitchen
4 cabinets, carpeting, mattresses, box springs, dressers, large televisions, and picnic
5 tables. Appliances and metal items such as bed frames, refrigerators, stoves, and
6 dishwashers and metal objects over three and a half feet in length or weighing
7 more than thirty-five pounds each are also bulk items. Bulk items shall not
8 include materials that are collected in the recycling program or construction
9 material/remodeling demolition debris.
- 10 C. "Commercial" means occupied with or engaged in commerce or work intended
11 for commerce, including non-profit and religious organizations.
- 12 D. "Commingled" means that paper, glass, plastic, and cans may be placed in the
13 same container.
- 14 E. "Dead animal" means the carcass or remains of any nonliving, nonhuman,
15 vertebrate creature. It does not include a condemned animal, an animal from a
16 slaughterhouse, and any animal normally considered as industrial refuse.
- 17 F. "Disposition" means the transportation, placement, or arrangement of recyclable
18 materials for all possible end uses except disposal as refuse.
- 19 G. "Generator" means the landlord or management company responsible for removal
20 of solid waste.
- 21 H. "Glass" means clear and colored glass bottles and containers. glass shall not
22 include crystal, ceramics, light bulbs, plate windows, or laminated, wired, or
23 mirrored glass.
- 24 I. "Multi-unit community" means ten or more apartments, townhouses or
25 condominiums located on a single property or contiguous properties under
26 common ownership or management, including public-assisted housing.
- 27 J. "Person" means an individual, firm, partnership, corporation, association,
28 cooperative enterprise, trust, municipal authority, federal institution or agency,
29 state institution or agency, municipality, other governmental agency or any other
30 entity or any group of such persons which is recognized by law as the subject of
31 rights and duties. In any provisions of this chapter prescribing a fine, penalty, or
32 imprisonment, the term "person" includes the officers and directors of a
33 corporation or other legal entity having officers and directors.
- 34 K. "Plastic" means an item made from moldable synthetic, natural, or organic
35 materials and formed into shapes.
- 36 L. "Recyclable materials" means the following materials and any future materials
37 that have a useful physical or chemical property including, but not limited, to:
38 newspapers, magazines and catalogs; books; cardboard and paper boxes; file
39 folders; packing paper; colored paper; wrapping paper; pizza boxes; corrugated
40 boxes; computer printouts; office papers; envelopes; paper bags; telephone books;
41 junk mail; aluminum; glass bottles; jars; steel and ferrous cans; and containers
42 including aerosol cans, HDPE-natural and HDPE-colored, PET-high grade.
- 43 M. "Recycling" means any process by which materials that would otherwise become
44 solid waste are collected, separated or processed, and returned to the economic
45 mainstream in the form of raw materials or products.

- 1 N. "Refuse" means all solid waste materials including garbage, dead animals, street
- 2 cleanings and solid market and industrial wastes, but not human excreta or
- 3 building construction wastes.
- 4 O. "Residential" means used or designed for single residence or limited to
- 5 residences, single or multifamily dwelling units.
- 6 P. "Solid waste" means refuse, recyclable, yard waste, and other waste matter, not to
- 7 include COMPOSTABLE FOOD WASTE AND explosives, poisons, corrosives,
- 8 flammable liquids, hot ashes and coals, medical waste, or other similar hazardous
- 9 materials and wastes.
- 10 Q. "Unit" means an enclosed space that consists of one or more rooms occupying all
- 11 or part of a floor or floors in a building of one or more floors or stories, but not
- 12 the entire building, and that is designed for use as a single residence.
- 13 R. "Wastes" means all unwanted materials, including liquid and solid materials.
- 14 S. "Waste minimization" means the voluntary reduction by the consumer of the
- 15 volume of refuse entering the solid waste stream.
- 16 T. "Yard trimmings" means grass clippings, weeds, discarded plants, leaves,
- 17 branches, brush, and tree wood waste up to four inches in diameter and no longer
- 18 than four feet in length.

21 **SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY**

22 **THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this ordinance shall take effect from the date

23 of its passage.
