Amendment Summary:

Amendment 2, offered by Ald. Gay on behalf of the Housing and Human Welfare Committee, eliminates the requirement that paper bags distributed by retailers must be made of at least 50% recycled material.

ONLY if Amendment 1 fails...

On page 2, strike lines 24 and 25, and renumber subsection B accordingly.

As the change would look in the resolution:

B. Requirements.

- 1. A retail establishment shall not provide a plastic carryout bag to a customer except as provided in Subsection C(3).
- 2. A retailer shall not provide a paper bag containing less than 50% post-consumer recycled content.
- 3.- The law shall be called the "City of Annapolis Plastic Bag Reduction Act."
