The Grants committee made its decisions based on the following:

- A. Project met the one of the following priorities:
 - 1 Provides services that sustain and empower youth, families and individuals to move towards an improved quality of life and self-sufficiency;
 - 2 Provides programs that preserve and enhance a community's character;
 - 3 Provides programs that contribute to a vibrant economy; or
 - 4 Promotes programs that are integral to community revitalization, economic development and environmental sustainability.

- B. The application criteria was that:
 - 1. Applicant shall had the administrative and financial capacity to carry out the project successfully and was in good standing with the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation;
 - 2. The project help meet the goals and objectives set forth above;
 - 3. The applicant demonstrated that the proposed activity shall provide maximum public benefit in relation to cost; and
 - 4. The applicant demonstrated the ability to leverage additional funds.

We decided the amount to fund by looking at previous allocations, reviewing the quarterly reports for FY 2019 and using our individual professional knowledge of the organizations' performance. We did not rank the applications but followed the selection the process used previously by the Finance Department to evaluate the applications.
