Subject: O-6-26: Oversight of the City's Firing Range

Purpose of Legislation

O-6-26 ordinance establishes oversight of the City's police firing range, allowing the Police Chief and Mayor to approve its use. The range is designated for sworn Police Department employees, with exceptions for other trained groups or police departments, but private guard forces are prohibited

Impact of legislation on operations

The Police Chief will now be granted the authority to approve the use of the City's police firing range, thereby enhancing responsibility and accountability for the Police Chief and enabling requests to be processed through the Annapolis Police Department in addition to the Mayor's Office.

Impact of legislation on staff needs

This legislation does not affect the staffing needs of the City.
