25 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 6.16.030 of the Annapolis City Code, on April 9, 2017, the  
26 Mayor submitted to the City Council a capital budget for the ensuing fiscal year  
27 and a Capital Improvement Program for the ensuing five fiscal years; and

29 **WHEREAS,** R-13-18 was referred to the Planning Commission, which held a meeting after  
30 proper public notice, to receive evidence and testimony as it judged to be  
31 relevant to the consideration of the Capital Improvement Program; and
