23 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 6.16.030 of the Annapolis City Code, on March 9, 2015, the  
24 Mayor submitted to the City Council a capital budget for the ensuing fiscal year  
25 and a Capital Improvement Program for the ensuing five fiscal years; and

27 **WHEREAS,** R-11-15 was referred to the Planning Commission, which held a meeting after  
28 proper public notice, to receive evidence and testimony as it judged to be  
29 relevant to the consideration of the Capital Improvement Program; and

31 **WHEREAS,** on \_\_\_\_\_, 2015, the Annapolis City Council held a public  
32 hearing on the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2016-2021; and
