15 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

17 **Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade/Diaspora Concert - Itinerant Merchant Sales**
18 **in the Historic District**

20 **FOR** the purpose of authorizing hawker, peddler, and itinerant merchant sales in the
21 Historic District in conjunction with the Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade and
22 Diaspora Concert.

23
24 **WHEREAS,** Section 7.40.090 of the City Code allows itinerant merchant sales as part of
25 a special event that is organized by a business association that has a
26 principal place of business within the City of Annapolis that represents
27 commercial enterprises in the immediate area of the proposed operation;
28 and

29
30 **WHEREAS,** certain special events proposed for the Historic District are not organized
31 by local business associations that have requested itinerant merchant sales;
32 and

33
34 **WHEREAS,** Section 7.40.090 of the City Code allows the City Council to designate
35 certain dates and times on which hawkers, peddlers and itinerant merchants
36 may sell in the Historic District as part of certain special events.

37
38 **WHEREAS,** the Mayor’s Office of the City of Annapolis presents “Diaspora: A Black
39 Heritage Celebration”, on April 13, 2019; and

41 **WHEREAS,** this African American cultural entertainment event will commence after the
42 2019 Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade; and

43
44 **WHEREAS,** this event is in partnership with The MLK Parade Committee, Annapolis
45 Recreation & Parks, and the Housing Authority of the City of Annapolis
46 (HACA).

1 **WHEREAS**, this free event will feature African American art, artifacts, food, music,
2 and storytelling to highlight significant contributions to American history
3 and culture.

6 **NOW THEREFORE**,

8 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that sales of merchandise
9 in the Historic District are allowed in conjunction with the following special event and in
10 the geographic location of this special event:
