17 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

19 **Municipal Regulation, Taxation and Disposition of Vacant and Blighted Buildings**

20  
21 **FOR** the purpose of respectfully requesting that the Maryland General Assembly amend the  
22 Local Government and the Tax – Property Articles of the Annotated Code of Maryland to  
23 authorize municipalities organized under Article XI-E of the Maryland Constitution,  
24 including Annapolis, to address public health and safety issues associated with vacant  
25 and blighted buildings.

27 **WHEREAS,** the Code of the City of Annapolis currently provides limited options to deal  
28 with nuisances associated with vacant properties that are ineffective generally in  
29 motivating the property owner to take timely action to prevent further waste of  
30 such property; and

31  
32 **WHEREAS,** the Code of the City of Annapolis currently provides a single remedy in cases  
33 where the owner of a blighted property unfit for human habitation refuses to  
34 undertake and complete repairs necessary to correct the conditions that present a  
35 hazard to public health and safety; and

36  
37 **WHEREAS,** the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland does not  
38 currently empower municipalities to establish and maintain a registry of vacant  
39 and blighted buildings, nor to establish misdemeanor status or civil penalties  
40 associated with the failure to register a vacant or blighted building; and

41  
42 **WHEREAS,** the Tax – Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland does not  
43 currently empower municipalities to establish and maintain special tax rates  
44 applicable to vacant and blighted buildings at rates greater than would apply to  
45 buildings that were not vacant or blighted; and

1 **WHEREAS,** the Local Government Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland does not  
2 currently empower municipalities to establish and maintain a special purpose  
3 fund comprising a Remediation Fund specially designated to administer  
4 facilitated registration, inspection, and remediation programs; and

6 **WHEREAS,** the Mayor and Alderpersons of the City of Annapolis desire to establish more  
7 effective means to minimize public health and safety issues associated with  
8 vacant and blighted buildings and have recommended that the City of Annapolis  
9 seek amendment of the Annotated Code of Maryland to address public health  
10 and safety issues associated with vacant and blighted buildings.

13 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the  
14 City of Annapolis respectfully requests that the Maryland General Assembly empower  
15 municipalities to establish a registry of vacant and blighted buildings and associated sanctions,  
16 and establish and maintain special tax rates applicable to vacant and blighted buildings.

18 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the  
19 City Clerk shall send a copy of this Resolution to the Maryland Governor, the Speaker of the  
20 House of Delegates, the President of the Senate and the Maryland Municipal League.
