18 **FOR** the purpose of amending the Annapolis Police and Fire Retirement Plan to comply with  
19 an IRS requirement that the Plan include specific language to address the potential for  
20 retirees to receive benefits from more than one City retirement plan.

22 **WHEREAS,** Section 3.36.010 of the Code of the City of Annapolis establishes and adopts by  
23 reference the amended and restated City of Annapolis Police and Fire Retirement  
24 Plan effective July 1, 2015; and

25  
26 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 3.36.010 of the Code of the City of Annapolis, the terms of  
27 the plan may be amended, from time to time, by resolution; and

29 **WHEREAS,** the Internal Revenue Service requires that the Annapolis Police and Fire  
30 Retirement Plan include specific language to address the potential for retirees to  
31 receive benefits from more than one City retirement plan.

33 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

35 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that in compliance with the  
36 Internal Revenue Service the Annapolis Police and Fire Retirement Plan is hereby amended to  
37 include specific language to address the potential for retirees to receive benefits from more than  
38 one City retirement plan.

40 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this  
41 resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage.
