Dr. Duah explained that R-29-14 legislation is intended to continue the current structure of the gold route. He discussed the proposal schedule for inclusion of the MT 14 bus route. M. Sams agreed to contact the MTA to discuss the possibility of stopping at the Community College if there is a need. Director Miller discussed the budgeting process and trends for the Transportation Department.

The Committee asked several questions of staff and its consultant to which they responded.

Alderman Budge clarified the amendments include: to amend the recommendation on the Gold route to adopt staff recommendation to have the circulator go from Church Circle to Edgewater and also connect to MT 14 bus; to charge \$1.00 for circulator and to keep the circulator on the full route. The Committee will vote favorably if these amendments move forward.

Alderman Pfeiffer moved to recommend favorably. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote.

O-26-14 Special Residential Parking District 2: Shipwright Street - For the purpose of removing the area on Shipwright Street zoned WME and the area adjacent
