Requires extensive professional planning experience of a progressively responsible nature at least three years of which must be at an executive or supervisory level, and possession of a master's degree from an accredited college or university in urban or regional planning; American Institute of Certified Planners certification OR THE ABILITY TO OBTAIN THE CERTIFICATION WITHIN ONE YEAR OF APPOINTMENT is required; or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.
