Subject: R-37-23: March on Washington 60th Anniversary Commemoration Waiver

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to waive City Code restrictions on Major Events at City Dock two weeks in a row and authorize the March on Washington 60th Anniversary Commemoration march and rally on August 26, 2023.

Impact of legislation on operations

The impact of this legislation regarding the March on Washington 60th Anniversary Commemoration event depends on assumptions made about what will happen if this legislation is not approved. If the event would take place as planned at City Dock but at a later date, then the various event impacts around traffic control and security would remain the same. If the event would take place on the same date but at an alternate location, those factors could be different. In general, events at City Dock require greater coordination and have larger impacts to traffic and security than events that occur in other places in the City.

Impact of legislation on staffing

Potential operational impacts described above would require staff overtime to implement in the Department of Transportation and the Annapolis Police Department.
