24 **WHEREAS,** Abandoned vehicles are a nuisance and a blight on our community, which pose a
25 safety hazard to pedestrians and motorists; and

27 **WHEREAS,** The current fines for abandoned vehicles are not sufficient to deter people from
28 abandoning their vehicles

30 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the
31 Fees Schedule shall be amended as follows:

Section	Description	Fine for Initial Offense	Fine for Repeat or Continuous Violations
12.44.030.A	Wrecked or inoperable vehicles on public property	\$50.00 plus damages	\$400 <u>250</u> .00 plus damages
12.44.040.B	Keeping wrecked or discarded vehicles	\$400 <u>250</u> .00 per day	\$400 <u>250</u> .00 per day
