Subject: O-4-24: Residency Requirement for Liquor Licensees Repeal

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to eliminate the residency requirement for receiving a City of Annapolis liquor license in accordance with state law; and generally dealing with license applications.

Impact of legislation on operations

This legislation brings the City into compliance with State law. It does not change any of the processes or procedures related to issuing liquor licenses and therefore should have minimal impacts to City operations.

Impact of legislation on staffing

This legislation is not expected to impact the staffing needs of the City.
