Expansion of Child Care Options in Annapolis

AMENDMENT 3 – ALD. SCHANDELMEIER

Amendment Summary:

Amendment 3 removes the City requirement that child care centers have outdoor play areas. Child Care Centers still must abide by State requirements for outdoor activity areas

MOTION:

On page 4, strike lines 6 through 35; on page 5 strike, lines 1 and 2; and insert the following:

Section 21.64.200 - Child Care Center.

A. Generally.

1. State Requirements. Child Care Centers shall meet requirements of Education Article §9.5 of the Maryland Code and COMAR § 13A.16.
2. Additional City Requirement. Child care centers shall have safe pick-up and drop-off locations, as determined by the Planning and Zoning Director.

B. Educational and Religious Affiliated Child Care Centers.

1. The use is subject to review and approval by the Department of Planning and Zoning.
2. A safe on-site drop-off and pick-up area shall be provided.
3. Adequate on-site parking sufficient to accommodate the users of the facility shall be provided, with signage to reserve spaces for the day care center.
