13 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

15 **Director of Public Works – Burr Vogel**

16
17 **FOR** the purpose of expressly confirming the appointment of Burr Vogel as the Director of
18 Public Works for the City of Annapolis; and consenting to compensate the Director.

19
20 **WHEREAS,** The Annapolis City Council is considering the appointment of Burr Vogel as
21 Director of Public Works;

22
23 **WHEREAS,** The Director of Public Works position became vacant on July 1, 2023; and

24
25 **WHEREAS,** Tricia Hopkins, Human Resources Manager of the City of Annapolis, conducted a
26 thorough review of Mr. Vogel’s qualifications and determined in her professional
27 opinion that Mr. Vogel’s qualifications exceed the minimum requirements of the
28 Annapolis Charter and that Mr. Vogel, by his background, education and
29 experience, is more than qualified to hold the position of Director of Public Works;
30 and

32 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Vogel is an experienced civil engineer with 26 years of experience directing
33 all aspects of engineering, construction, and facilities management, as well as
34 creating and implementing innovative organizational development initiatives to
35 achieve the highest quality and most cost-effective outcomes; and

37 **WHEREAS,** From 2021 to 2022, Mr. Vogel was a senior project executive at Jacobs Technology
38 in Bangor, Washington, leading a staff of 230 and providing facility operation,
39 maintenance, and repairs at Naval Base Kitsap, which contains 970 buildings and
40 nine million square feet of facilities at the Bangor Trident Submarine Base, Puget
41 Sound Naval Shipyard, and four additional outlying sites; and

1 **WHEREAS,** From 2019 to 2021, Mr. Vogel was executive officer for Naval Facilities
2 Engineering Systems Command Washington in Washington, DC, where he
3 directed 1300 civilian engineers, architects, and other professionals delivering full
4 lifecycle facility and infrastructure services worth over \$1 billion per year to 10
5 Department of Defense campuses in the Nation Capital Region; and
6

7 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Vogel's prior experience included deputy commander of operations for Naval
8 Facilities Engineering Systems Command in Washington, DC, director of public
9 works for Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickman in Hawaii, chief operations officer for
10 Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command Hawaii, and director of public
11 works for Naval Support Activity Bethesda in Maryland; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Subsection 3.08.030(F) of the Annapolis City Code, the appointment
14 and initial salary of the Director of Public Works is subject to confirmation by the
15 City Council.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

18 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Council has reviewed
19 the qualifications of Burr Vogel and is satisfied that he is well qualified for the Director of Public
20 Works position; and

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Council
23 expressly confirms the appointment of Burr Vogel to the position of Director of Public Works and
24 consents to compensate Mr. Vogel as Director of Public Works in the amount of \$184,940 per
25 annum.
