36 **SECTION I: BE IT ESTABLISHED AND ORDAINED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY**  
37 **COUNCIL** that the Code of the City of Annapolis shall be amended to read as follows:

7 either on foot or by means of any vehicle, at any time between ~~the hours of nine p.m. and~~  
8 ~~six a.m. the following morning~~sunset and sunrise, except for the purpose of attending or  
9 participating in an activity, program or event sponsored by or conducted under the  
10 auspices of the Department of Recreation and Parks.

12 **11.12.085 - Street End Park Hours**

13 A person may not enter or be present on the City property known as a street end park,  
14 either on foot or by means of any vehicle, at any time between sunset and sunrise except  
15 for the purpose of attending or participating in an activity, program or event sponsored by  
16 or conducted under the auspices of the Department of Recreation and Parks.

18 **11.12.090 - Truxtun Park hours.**

19 A person may not enter or be present on the City property known as Truxtun Park, either  
20 on foot or by means of any vehicle or vessel, at any time between ~~the hours of nine p.m.~~  
21 ~~and six a.m. the following morning between December 1st and March 31st of each year,~~  
22 ~~or at any time between the hours of eleven p.m. and six a.m. the following morning~~  
23 ~~between April 1st and November 30th of each year unless otherwise posted on the~~  
24 ~~property by the Director of the Department of Recreation and Parks, after reasonable~~  
25 ~~public notice of any proposed change in hours~~sunset and sunrise, except for the purpose  
26 of attending or participating in an activity, program or event sponsored by or conducted  
27 under the auspices of the Department of Recreation and Parks.
