Amendment #1

Taxi Fees

Rationale: The Maryland State Legislature has given the Public Services Commission state-wide authority for the licensing and regulation of Transportation Network Companies such as Uber and Lyft. The Annapolis Taxi Industry has requested regulatory and financial relief to help remain competitive. This amendment implements fiscal relief to the extent that the City is able. See accompanying budget change above.

Amendment #2

Solid Waste Fees

	Current	Proposed
10.16.160 Annual fee for trash collection from dwelling units within the city	323	249

Rationale: The Solid Waste Fund is scheduled to finish FY15 with close to \$4 million in accumulated fund balance, almost all of which is unassigned. The existing fund balance provides adequate buffer for unexpected cost increases and future rate shocks. The amendment proposes adjusting the fee so that the fund operates break-even instead of with a six-figure surplus. See related budget change above.
