CAMPS FOR YOUTH

CRAB is requesting support from the City of Annapolis to support its Youth Sailing Camps in collaboration with the City Police Department

CRAB provides sailing instruction to students aged 8-17 from underserved communities with Resource Officers through floating classrooms where they learn to steer the boat, adjust the sails, be safe on the water, and develop racing strategies in a collaborative environment.

Our program helps to develop positive and trusting relationships between the students and Resource Officers as they learn how to sail as a team.
