14 **Designating a Resident Agent for Service of Process**

16 **FOR** the purpose of designating a resident agent for service of process under certain
17 circumstances; and matters generally relating thereto.

19 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Md. Code Annotated, Local Government Article, Section 1-1301
20 each governmental entity shall have a resident agent who is a resident of the State;
21 a Maryland corporation; or an officer of the governmental entity; and

23 **WHEREAS**, a governmental entity shall designate or change its resident agent by filing for
24 record with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation; and

25
26 **WHEREAS**, the Office of Law includes the general counsel for the City of Annapolis who is
27 designated as the City Attorney; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the current City Attorney for the City of Annapolis is D. Michael Lyles who
30 qualifies to be resident agent because he is an officer of the governmental entity.

32 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

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34 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the individual to accept
35 service of process for the City of Annapolis is the current City Attorney, D. Michael Lyles.

37 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that D.
38 Michael Lyles is specifically named as the current resident agent duly authorized to accept service
39 of process for the City of Annapolis.
