Subject: O-23-24: Parking and Towing Regulations

Purpose of legislation

The purpose of this legislation is to eliminate the requirement that towing companies be within one mile of the City; allow City contractors to oversee towing; and generally update parking and towing regulations in Titles 7 and 12.

Impact of legislation on operations

The City appreciates the collaborative effort with the Annapolis Police Department and the Department of Transportation to develop this legislation. It will make towing easier to license and easier to use. Abandoned vehicles, particularly larger trucks, will be able to be removed more expeditiously, which is beneficial to residents, parking enforcement, and APD.

Impact of legislation on staffing

This legislation is expected to make interacting with towing companies easier, which should save some staff time, though the amount of time is expected to be nominal.
