Since my retirement from my positions as General Manager of Annapolis Sailing School and Public Information Officer for Annapolis Boat Shows in 2006, I have remained active and involved in the maritime industry in the Chesapeake area.

I currently hold a 100 ton Inland Master's Coast Guard License.

From 2005 to 2011 I served as captain on the Schooners *Woodwind*, operating out of Annapolis harbor.

From 2011 to date I have served as part time captain on Watermark vessels operating out of Annapolis harbor.

From 2006 to date I serve as co-host on a one hour weekly live talk show on radio station WNAV entitled the WNAV BOAT SHOW.

Since 2005 I have been a free lance boating writer, with boating related articles appearing in Nor'easter Magazine, Sail Magazine, Spinsheet magazine and Proptalk Magazine. I currently write a monthly column in Proptalk titled Boat Shop Reports as well as occasional boat reviews and feature articles.
