Updating Parking Enforcement and Rulemaking Responsibilities Chapters 2.36, 12.08 and 12.32

For the purpose of updating the parking enforcement and rulemaking responsibilities in Chapters 2.36, 12.08, and 12.32.

Pursuant to a Management Agreement dated February 23, 2016 between the City of Annapolis and Central Parking System of Maryland, Inc. (also known as SP+), the City hired SP+ to manage certain parking matters within the City limits, including, parking enforcement.

The proposed changes to Chapters 2.36, 12.08, and 12.32 are needed to clearly provide SP+ with the authority to perform its obligations under the Management Agreement, and to also clarify other conflicts between existing Code sections as to which department possesses responsibilities for these matters.

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
