Legends is a tech startup that teaches positive mental wellness to 7-11 yos through interactive digital media.

Ever Scouts was a "next-generation," gender-inclusive Scouting program that taught 7-11yos social, emotional, and leadership development skills through interactive, instructor-led training.

- **Program Design:** Built proprietary model ("The 12 Keys") for teaching social and emotional learning; led a research team of 4 to design the program model for a new, digital approach to Scouting, including strategy for curriculum, instruction, assessment, and parent engagement. Piloted model as a summer camp, managing a full-time staff of 4.
- Team Management: Managed a Program & Curriculum Team of 9, including a Director of Research & Evaluation, Curriculum Manager, Instructional Manager, Instructors, Program Associate, and numerous consultants/curriculum designers, to build a highly successful "next-generation Scouting" program with 11 chapters across 5 cities.
- Content Creation: Worked collaboratively with creative team to create a best-in-class curriculum suite, including 30 hour-long, interactive trainings and 120 mini-lessons, that combined research-based teaching with engaging storytelling to help kids build core SEL skills. Provided research briefs to inform initial content scoping, gave line edits on script drafts, and even starred in video content.
- Evaluation: Led concept design for our Responsibility Quotient (RQ), a new format for measuring SEL proficiency through evidence-based stealth assessments.
