Community Grant Program

6.16.060 - Priorities for making operating and/or capital grants to non-profit organizations under the City of Annapolis Community Grant Program.

- ▶ An operating grant" shall provide support for the day-to-day costs of running the non-profit organization.
- ▶ A "capital grant" shall provide support for the purchase of property, the construction, remodeling, or expansion of a facility, or purchase of equipment by a non-profit organization.



Community Grant Program

- ▶ Subject to the availability of funds
 - ▶ the City will consider funding operating and/or capital grants
 - ▶ Proposals must meet one of the following priorities:
 - ▶ Provides services that sustain and empower youth, families and individuals to move towards an improved quality of life and self-sufficiency;
 - ▶ Provides programs that preserve and enhance a community's character;
 - ▶ Provides programs that contribute to a vibrant economy; or
 - ▶ Promotes programs that are integral to community revitalization, economic development and environmental sustainability.





The Committee:


- ▶ convened to review and evaluate applications.
- ▶ submitted recommendations to the City Council based on the evaluation.
- ▶ Each member was assigned six proposals to review
- ▶ One proposal was deemed unqualified prior to review
- ▶ facilitated by the Assistant City Manager

- ▶ Total requests \$777,210
- ▶ Multitude of Services

 - ▶ 2 Programs Serving Families
 - ▶ 3 Recreational Programs for Children and Youth
 - ▶ 2 Educational Programs for Adults
 - ▶ 3 Homelessness and Addiction Prevention Programs
 - ▶ 4 Educational Programs for Youth
 - ▶ 4 Services for Adults
 - ▶ 12 Enhance Arts and Culture

- ▶ We did not receive proposal from programs that are integral to community revitalization, economic development and environmental sustainability




