14 **Hurricane Ida - Small Business Financing**
15 **KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of Annapolis**

16 **FOR** the purpose of supporting the distribution of grant funds through the Maryland Department
17 of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) Neighborhood BusinessWorks
18 Program (NBW Program) to KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of
19 Annapolis, which was severely impacted by the Hurricane Ida disaster.

21 **WHEREAS,** on September 1, 2021, spurred by Hurricane Ida, an EF-2 Tornado ripped through
22 Annapolis with peak wind speeds reaching approximately 125 mph. In the
23 aftermath, however, several small businesses were forced to shutter; and

25 **WHEREAS,** The Maryland DHCD has received funding for this current fiscal year through the
26 NBW Program to support Maryland small businesses affected by the Hurricane Ida
27 disaster; and

29 **WHEREAS,** KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie Academy of Annapolis has applied to
30 the NBW Program for financing to replace and install a new building control
31 system, and to assist with roof repairs and replacement at 1919 West Street, Suite
32 100, Annapolis, MD 21401; and

34 **WHEREAS,** in order for grant funds to be released to KA Annapolis Holdings LLC d/b/a Kiddie
35 Academy of Annapolis, the City of Annapolis is required to show its support for
36 the project by passing a resolution endorsing the financing; and

38 **WHEREAS,** the deadline for the City of Annapolis to submit the adopted Resolution to the
39 DHCD is January 28, 2022; and
