Subject: R-5-22, 2022 State of Emergency Extension

This resolution will extend the State of Emergency declared by the Mayor on December 23, 2021 for an additional 90 days from this resolution's date of passage.

During the State of Emergency, the Mayor's powers include, but are not limited to, the authority to:

- A. Appoint an incident commander;
- B. Implement all or part of the City's continuity of government plan, continuity of operations plan, or other related programs and plans;
- C. Declare a curfew in all or any part of the City pursuant to Section 1140.010 of the City Code;
- D. Authorize the use of City-owned property by any other governmental agency or person during the State of Emergency;
- E. Direct the Harbormaster to limit access to City waters or any other action provided in Title 15 of the City Code; and
- F. Take such other and further actions authorized by the Charter and Code of the City of Annapolis or the Annotated Code of Maryland, or otherwise needed to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Annapolis.
