15 **A RESOLUTION** concerning

16 **Designating City Attorney Anthony P. Kupersmith as the Resident Agent for**
17 **Services of Process**

19 **FOR** the purpose of designating a resident agent for service of process under certain
20 circumstances; and matters generally relating thereto.

22 **WHEREAS,** Pursuant to the Md. Local Government Code Ann. § 1-1301 each governmental
23 entity shall have a resident agent who is a resident of the State; a Maryland
24 corporation; or an officer of the governmental entity; and

26 **WHEREAS,** A governmental entity shall designate or change its resident agent by filing for
27 record with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation; and

29 **WHEREAS,** The Office of Law includes the general counsel for the City of Annapolis, who is
30 designated as the City Attorney; and

32 **WHEREAS,** The current City Attorney for the City of Annapolis is Anthony P. Kupersmith, who
33 qualifies to be resident agent because he is an officer of the governmental entity.

35 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the
36 individual authorized to accept service of process on behalf of the City of Annapolis is the current
37 City Attorney, Anthony P. Kupersmith.

39 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that Anthony
40 P. Kupersmith is specifically named as the current resident agent duly authorized to accept service
41 of process for the City of Annapolis.

1 **AND BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that this
2 resolution shall take effect upon passage.
