Amendment Summary:

Amendment 4 removes the exception allowing non-resident Commission members, adds an arts-familiarity qualification for members, and adds a three-year staggered term, consistent with the general board and commission standards proposed for Chapter 2.48.

MOTION:

On page 7, strike line 27 in its entirety: “3. Members may reside outside the City to allow for regional arts expertise.”; and insert the following new paragraphs, renumbered 3 through 5:

- “3. Each member shall have demonstrated knowledge, interest, or expertise in the visual or performing arts.
- 4. Members shall serve terms of three years, commencing on July 1 of the year of appointment, or until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 5. Terms shall be staggered so that no more than one-third of the memberships expire in any one year, to the extent practicable, given the size of the Commission.”

B. Membership, Appointment, Terms (Residency).

1. The Commission shall consist of five members.
2. Efforts shall be made to have the commission comprise residents from throughout the City.

3. Each member shall have demonstrated knowledge, interest, or expertise in the visual or performing arts.
4. Members shall serve terms of three years, commencing on July 1 of the year of appointment, or until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
5. Terms shall be staggered so that no more than one-third of the memberships expire in any one year, to the extent practicable, given the size of the Commission

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
