23 **Alcoholic Beverages – Election Days**

25 **FOR** the purpose of expressing the sense of the City Council concerning a proposed
26 amendment to Article 2B, Section 11-401(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

28 **WHEREAS,** The General Assembly of Maryland has drafted a Bill Entitled “City of
29 Annapolis – Alcoholic Beverages – Election Days; and

30
31 **WHEREAS,** the purpose of that Bill is to add the City of Annapolis to the list of subdivisions
32 in which a holder of an alcoholic beverage license may exercise all of the
33 privileges conferred by that license on the day of any election in Annapolis; and

35 **WHEREAS,** currently, Annapolis is one of two subdivisions in Maryland wherein a holder of
36 an alcoholic beverage license may not exercise all of the privileges conferred by
37 that license on the day of any election; and

39 **WHEREAS,** the effective date of the Bill, should it be enacted by the General Assembly of
40 Maryland, shall be July 1, 2015.

42 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the
43 City Council is strongly in favor of the proposed amendment to Article 2B, Section 11-401(b) of
44 the Annotated Code of Maryland, which would add the City of Annapolis to the list of
45 subdivisions in which a holder of an alcoholic beverage license may exercise all of the privileges
46 conferred by that license on the day of any election in Annapolis.
