16 **Waiver of Commercial Mooring Permit Fees for Annapolis Community Boating**

17 **FOR** the purpose of waiving the commercial mooring permit fees (\$1,920 per commercial
18 mooring permit per year in fiscal year 2015) for Annapolis Community Boating, a local
19 501(c)(3) organization.

21 **WHEREAS,** Annapolis Community Boating is a local 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to
22 making boating accessible and fun for all; and

24 **WHEREAS,** Annapolis Community Boating requests the use of two commercial moorings
25 near the Ellen Moyer Nature Park Boating Center; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the fee for a commercial mooring permit in fiscal year 2015 is \$1,920 per
28 commercial mooring permit per year pursuant to Resolution 10-14 Amended;

31 **WHEREAS,** Annapolis Community Boating has requested a waiver of \$3,840 for two
32 commercial mooring permits in recognition of the organization's significant
33 contributions to the community, specifically its youth programming activities.

35 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the \$3,840
36 in commercial mooring permit fees are waived for the use of two commercial moorings near the
37 Ellen Moyer Nature Park Boating Center.

39 **AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the permit fee
40 waiver shall be in effect for one year from which date that Annapolis Community Boating begins
41 use of the commercial moorings for which the permit fees have been waived.
