O-31-24 Amendment 1 - Savidge

Planning and Zoning Director Jakubiak and Legislative & Policy Analyst Reuter were present to answer question from the committee.

**Committee Amendment #1-**On page 3, strike lines 1 through 18, and on line 2 insert: a. Requirements. i. No sign shall: (1) obstruct a clear view to and from traffic along any street right-of-way, entrance or exit; (2) be placed on a public sidewalk. ii. Removable signs that are temporarily placed around the vehicle shall not be more than 25 feet from the vehicle. iii. Signs not attached to the vehicle shall be removed and stored when the food truck is not in operation. b. Prohibited Signs. i. animated signs; ii. billboards; iii. flashing signs; iv. rotating signs; v. snipe signs (non-governmental signs attached to trees or poles); and vi. signage containing profanity or lewd or obscene images." Alderwoman Finlayson moved recommend favorably. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote. Change "temporary" to "removable" signs. Alderman Arnett moved to withdraw. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote. Alderwoman Finlayson requested the "Staffing Impact Note" be added to the legislation.

Alderman Arnett moved to postpone O-31-24 until the next meeting January 9th, 2024. Seconded. CARRIED on voice vote.
