

## STAFF REPORT ON PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Subject: CA-2-22. Article II - Board of Supervisors of Elections

This Resolution for a Charter Change is for the purpose of expanding the Board of Supervisors of Elections from three members to five members.

The old definition of the board size: There is a board of supervisors of elections of the City of Annapolis, consisting of three residents in and voters of the city, two of whom shall always be selected from the leading political parties of the state, one from each of such parties. The third member may be selected from either of the leading political parties of the state or from any other political party.

The new definition of the board size: The Board of Supervisors of Elections shall be comprised of five residents who are also registered voters of the city: two of whom are from the leading political parties of the state, two of whom are from either of the leading political parties of the state, and one of whom is not a member of either of the leading political parties of the state.
