22 **Amending Parking Fines**

24 **FOR** the purpose of removing a graduated fines structure for repeat violations; adding a  
25 multiplier for repeat violations; and matters relating to amending special  
26 residential parking district fines imposed for parking violations.

28 **WHEREAS,** The City of Annapolis engaged the services of a Contractor to manage off-  
29 street parking within the City on March 1, 2016; and

30  
31 **WHEREAS,** The implementation of Contractor’s services has highlighted discrepancies  
32 between parking fines authorized by the Annapolis City Council and prior  
33 practices in Parking Enforcement in the City.

35 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL**  
36 that the FY2017 Fines Schedule is amended as follows:
