AMENDMENT NO. 10 WITHDRAWN

On Page 5, line 37, strike "685,000" and substitute "685,000"; and

In Appendix D, page 36 (Traffic Signal Rehabilitation), under Status, strike "The Church Circle traffic signals have been identified as the highest priority to replace due to significant structural deterioration" and substitute "Highest priority identified as Church Circle, which is delayed to study alignment of signals relative to the Hillman Garage replacement and CDAC impact. Next highest priorities are Randall St. at Prince George St., King George St. at College Ave., and King George St. at Maryland Ave"; and under Scope, strike "An extensive list of reconstruction and upgrade projects has been identified and prioritized", and substitute "Projects will be constructed based on prioritized list. Due to delay, Church Circle signals will be temporarily structurally repaired"; under Timing, strike "The Church Circle replacement signal design is expected to be completed by June 2021.", and substitute "FY22 funding to be used for structural repairs for Church Circle signals and design and construction of signals on King George St. at College Ave. and Maryland Ave".

This amendment delays the replacement of traffic signals at Church Circle and FY 2022 funding will be used for structural repairs for Church Circle signals and the design and construction of signals on King George Street at College Avenue and Maryland Avenue.
