26 the Mayor submitted to the City Council a capital budget for the ensuing fiscal
27 year and a Capital Improvement Program for the ensuing five fiscal years; and

30 proper public notice, to receive evidence and testimony as it judged to be
31 relevant to the consideration of the Capital Improvement Program; and
