# Community Grant Program

2

**6.16.060 - Priorities for making operating and/or capital grants to non-profit organizations under the City of Annapolis Community Grant Program.**

- ▶ An operating grant" shall provide support for the day-to-day costs of running the non-profit organization.
- ▶ A "capital grant" shall provide support for the purchase of property, the construction, remodeling, or expansion of a facility, or purchase of equipment by a non-profit organization.





# Community Grant Program

- ▶ Subject to the availability of funds
  - ▶ the City will consider funding operating and/or capital grants
  - ▶ Proposals must meet one of the following priorities:
    - ▶ Provides services that sustain and empower youth, families and individuals to move towards an improved quality of life and self-sufficiency;
    - ▶ Provides programs that preserve and enhance a community's character;
    - ▶ Provides programs that contribute to a vibrant economy; or
    - ▶ Promotes programs that are integral to community revitalization, economic development and environmental sustainability.

## The Process

### The Committee:

- ▶ convened to review and evaluate applications.
- ▶ submitted recommendations to the City Council based on the evaluation.
- ▶ was made up of grant writers and managers from:
  - ▶ Annapolis Police Department
  - ▶ Annapolis Fire Department
  - ▶ Department of Planning and Zoning
- ▶ was facilitated by the Assistant City Manager

- ▶ 30 applications
- ▶ Total requests \$646,828
- ▶ Multitude of Services
  - ▶ 2 Food Programs for Children and Youth
  - ▶ 5 Educational Programs for Children and Youth
  - ▶ 1 Mentoring and Life Skills for Children and Youth
  - ▶ 2 Educational Programs for Adults
  - ▶ 3 Homeless and Addiction Prevention Programs
  - ▶ 10 Services for Youth and Adults
  - ▶ 7 Enhance Arts and Culture
